
Pastoral Message

Faith communities can be pretty complex. In recent years they have become more so as a result of new technology, COVID-19 and big changes in Australian culture. That's why it's exciting for our parish to be invited to partner with 12 others from across our Diocese as we seek to navigate these complex times together.

As part of the Diocese's Resource Church Project, St John's Cathedral have pulled together parishes to form a co-learning community within the Anglican Church Southern Queensland focused on complexity and sense making in these unprecedented times.

Seeking to form leaders to discern and engage with what is emerging in their communities, *Adapting Ministry in Complex Times* focuses on:

- building shared capabilities between clergy and laity for working in complexity
- addressing current issues of concern in the life of faith communities
- practical application through implementing and monitoring innovative initiatives.
