Marsden Tooth Memorial Home. While the sale of the church is proposed the parish will not be closed. The ministry of St Paul's in our local community will continue.

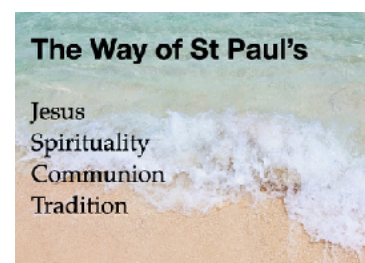
