

Pastoral Message

With June behind us, so too is a significant body of work. As much as we love our buildings and their history, liquidating under utilised assets for the benefit of the wider community, significantly reducing our input costs and re-orientating our volunteer base away from institutional administration and toward ministry releases us to focus on the church's core purpose of making and nourishing disciples by sharing the love of God in worship and service. We are able to travel lightly, love completely and serve wholeheartedly.

The last few years of planning and strategising culminated in the work we have undertaken these past few months. It has not been easy or simple, but by your faithfulness and unity we have prevailed under great pressure. The hard decisions we have made now give us a future - resources, focus, community, a Chapel. Now, we set about laying the foundation for that future.

Over the next few months Parish Council will lead a process of discernment and planning. This process will create a framework for ministry for our community aimed at shaping not only our immediate next steps but with a view to shaping Anglican ministry in Manly for many years to come.
